

 - ✓ N Rivergate Overcrossing, \$7M, 2017 (Port of Portland)
- Grant size this round: \$5M \$25M











Grant Benefits


- Reduces shared financial burden:

 - ✓ LID burden on affordable housing development reduced by \$1.5M

 - ✓ Reduces General Fund risk
- NW Johnson St Neighborhood Greenway extension to Union Station, connecting Old Town / Chinatown, Pearl, Slabtown, NW
- Leverages 4 million sf smart growth development
