





## Occupied Housing Units in Portland, OR






## Average Rent in Portland, OR

Over the past month, the average rent for a studio apartment in Portland decreased by -2% to \$1,225. The average rent for a 1-bedroom apartment increased by 2% to \$1,499, and the average rent for a 2-bedroom apartment decreased by -1% to \$1,783.
