Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

PCC 6.06.220 requires the City Council to conduct a public hearing(s) to determine whether the Central Eastside property management license fee should be terminated. This is required in 2022 and every ten years thereafter. The Central Eastside Industrial District was formed at the request of property managers/owners to allow them to fund additional sidewalk operations, safety and outreach services, streetscape improvement, and community grants. The district has been in existence since 2019.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The resolution does not create a financial impact. The ordinance to award the contract will have a fiscal impact and will be included at that time. However, the resolution allows the Central Eastside Industrial District to continue and the impacts to all are similar to those historically.

Community impacts and community involvement:

Providing additional services for this district contributes to the attractiveness and livability of the Central Eastside Industrial District for residents, businesses, and visitors, as well as the City as a whole. A vital Central Eastside increases tourism and business revenues, which increases city tax revenues that support the General Fund.
