

Ordinance No. 9620.

An Ordinance granting to Chinese Residents of Portland the right and privilege of celebrating their New Year Festivities.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the Chinese Residents of the City of Portland be and are hereby granted the privilege to explode fire crackers within the limits of the City of Portland, from the 11th day of February 1896 to and including the 26th day of February 1896, during the following hours, viz:

On February 11th 1896, from 6 o'clock to 11 o'clock P.M., and from midnight until 7 o'clock A.M., and from 6 o'clock to 9 o'clock P.M. on February 12th 1896.

From February 12th 1896 to February 26th 1896, from 5 o'clock to 7 o'clock A.M., and from 6 o'clock to 9 o'clock P.M., of each day: PROVIDED, that no fire crackers shall be exploded on Sunday February 16th and Sunday February 23rd 1896.
