

Do you think Gilkey / Fais should have a school zone? 81 responses






I am worried for my children's safety getting to and from school. We live only 3 blocks from school, but have to cross Cornell Rd to get there. I would love to be able to walk, but it is not safe to cross Cornell with cars traveling 45+ mph and no school zone or crosswalk.

Gilkey is one of the few schools I know of in the Metro area not protected with a school zone. Traffic congestion usually keeps the speed low enough that a school zone wouldn't actually change travel time much while making everyone safer.
