# **A Tale of Two Systems**

#### **Residential** (franchised)

- Serves single-family and small plexes
- 9 franchised haulers operate in territories
- City sets rates and service levels
- Rates include 5% franchise fee to BPS

### **Commercial** (open market)

- Serves businesses, multifamily properties, and construction debris
- 26 permitted haulers operate throughout city
- Customers negotiate with hauler for services and rates
- Haulers pay \$12.60 fee to BPS per ton of garbage



# Residential Rate Review Process



- Hauler financial reports reviewed by accountant
- Rates cover:
  - average cost of service +
  - target operating margin +
  - franchise fee
- Waste reduction policy

## **Key Rate Factors**



### Going up...

- Metro Tip Fees
- Fuel
- Wages
- Inflation

### Going down...

- Recycling processing fees
- Clean Fleet costs


#### **Recommended Residential Rates**

Primary Garbage Service Levels	Current Rate	Proposed Rate FY22-23	Increase	Share of Customers*
Every 4 Weeks	\$27.15	\$27.35	\$0.20	5%
20-Gallon	\$29.85	\$30.15	\$0.30	6%
35-Gallon	\$34.55	\$34.90	\$0.35	45%
60-Gallon	\$39.05	\$39.45	\$0.40	33%
90-Gallon	\$45.30	\$45.70	\$0.40	6%

Terrain Fee: \$0.30 (7%) increase to \$4.85



#### Over time rates beat inflation





## **Commercial Tonnage Fee**

- Funds management of commercial waste collection
- We're doing more! Expanding services and improving systems for businesses and multifamily residents while addressing racial equity
- Recommend \$2.00 per ton increase to bring fee to \$14.60 per ton for commercial garbage

 July 1, 2022: Adopted residential rates and commercial tonnage fee take effect



2019 = 750 cans

2024 = 1700 cans
