

ORDINANCE NO. 147004

An Ordinance amending the personal service contract between the City and Paul Norr for services as a part-time hearings officer by increasing the compensation to the equivalent of the pay rate of a full-time hearings officer after three years plus six percent (6%) and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Professional services as a part-time hearings officer are rendered by Paul Norr, attorney at law, pursuant to a personal services contract authorized by Ordinance No. 147004 as subsequently amended from time to time.
2. That at the time of entering into such an agreement, it was understood that the part-time hearings officer should be compensated at a rate equal to the rate established by the City Council for a full-time City employee in Class No. 0720 - Hearings Officer.
3. That Mr. Norr has completed three years service as a part-time hearings officer and should be compensated at the rate of a full-time hearings officer after three years service plus six percent (6%) in lieu of City pickup of PERS benefits.
4. Funds are available for such increase within the budget of Office of the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The agreement between the City and Paul Norr for services as a part-time hearings officer as authorized by Ordinance No. 147004 and as subsequently amended from time to time is hereby further amended to provide that effective January 1, 1982, the rate of compensation to Mr. Norr shall be increased from \$18.08 to \$19.22 per hour. Such agreement is further amended to provide that in the future during the term of such agreement, Mr. Norr shall be compensated at the rate of full-time hearings officer after three years service as provided by the City's compensation plan plus six percent (6%) in lieu of PERS pickup.


- b. This Ordinance shall be an effective amendment to the personal service contract between the City and Paul Norr being City Contract No. 17652 upon written acceptance of the terms and conditions of this Ordinance by Mr. Norr.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that there may be no delay in providing for appropriate compensation of the part-time hearings officer for his services; therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
