In correcting the Ordinance, Edna Cevera of your office removed Exhibit IV, PIR, and reduced the total supplemental budget by \$327,000.

ORDINANCE NO. 152863

An Ordinance adopting a supplemental budget of \$21,997,648, increasing resources and requirements in various City funds, making appropriations from those funds in accordance with the supplemental budget, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:
