# ORDINANCE NO. 152865

An Ordinance creating 60 positions, abolishing 52 positions, and establishing effective dates within certain operating bureaus, establishing salary rates for the Compensation Plan, authorizing salary adjustments which are exceptions to the Compensation Plan, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On January 27, 1982, the City Council received the Second Quarter Budget Review for FY 1981-82 in which personnel reclassification actions have been identified in several City agencies.
- 2. The personnel actions have been approved by the Bureau of Personnel Services or the Civil Service Board, and an effective date has been established.
- 3. Several bueaus require funds be transferred between line items or major object codes within their budgets, or additional appropriation transferred from General Operating Contingency to support the enactment of the personnel actions. These funds are transferred in a separate ordinance.
- 4. Because of demonstrated expertise, individuals in various bureaus should be appointed to the positions specified at salary rates which are exceptions to the current Compensation Plan.
- 5. The Budget Division of the Office of Fiscal Administration has prepared this ordinance creating and abolishing positions and amending the Compensation Plan, consistent with the amended First Quarter Budget Review.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Positions are created with salary rates in accordance with the current Compensation Plan or as established in c., below, and as shown in Exhibit A, attached.
- b. Positions are abolished as shown in Exhibit B, attached.
- c. Hourly salary rates for position classifications not in the current Compensation Plan and salary rates for existing position classifications in the current Compensation Plan are established in accordance with Exhibit C.
- d. The following named individuals are appointed as specified:
