This is to advise the City of Portland, Oregon, that I hereby accept the terms and provisions of





ORDINANCE NO. 152867

An Ordinance authorizing extension of time to complete contract between the City and the Portland Development Commission for I-505 Relocation Assistance Advisory services by 6 months, providing for acceptance, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 151440 passed by Council April 22, 1980 authorized an agreement, No. 19475, between the City and the Portland Development Commission (P.D.C.) to provide project management for the I-505 (I-405 extension) Business Relocation Advisory Assistance Project.
- 2. The agreement provided for work to begin on January 2, 1981 and to continue for 12 months unless extended by written agreement between P.D.C. and the City.
- 3. The consultant performing the field work for this project has been granted a 250-day extension to their contract.
- 4. The consultant time extension has resulted in a delay of approximately 6 months in P.D.C.'s scheduled completion of their portion of the project.
- 5. The time of completion for the contract needs to be extended 6 months to July 2, 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Agreement No. 19475 between the City and the Portland Development Commission is changed by increasing the contract duration to 18 months from January 2, 1981.
- b. This amendment shall be effective upon receipt of a acceptance of this amendment, by Portland Development Commission, in a form acceptable to the City Auditor.
- c. All other provisions of Agreement No. 19475 shall remain in force and effect.


ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in implementing this change may result in failure to complete the work within the revised project schedule, resulting in further delays in realization of the benefits of this project to effected businesses, therefore this Ordinance shall be in force and effect, subject to the acceptance specified in Section 1 b, from and after its passage by the Council.
