The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- That Neil Farnham, Architect, 124 S.W. Yamhill Street, Portland 97204, has requested on the behalf of Warehouse Investment Corp., owners of the property at 2424 N. Interstate Avenue, permission to construct, use, and maintain a covered stairway through the vaulted sidewalk adjacent thereto.
- 2. The purpose of this request is to provide ingress and egress from street level to the basement of their building and thereby providing better usability.
- The granting of the requested permission will not be detrimental to the public interest under certain conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A revocable permit is hereby granted to Warehouse Investment Corp., 111 S.W. Columbia Street, Portland, OR 97201, permittee, to construct, use, and maintain a covered stairway in the vaulted sidewalk adjacent to Tax Lot 4 of Blocks 53 and 54, Albina Addition, located as shown on the plan marked "Exhibit A" attached to and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) This permit is for the use of the street area only, and shall not exempt the permittee from obtaining any license or permit required by the City Code or Ordinances for any act to be performed under this permit, nor shall this permit waive the provisions of any City Code, Ordinance, or the City Charter, except as herein stated.
 - (2) This permit is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Council and no expenditure of money or lapse of time, or other act or thing, shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the permittee any vested or other right. Upon revocation of this permit by the Council, the permittee shall within 90 days remove said stairway and restore the sidewalk area as required by and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.

- (3) The permittee shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property, including legal fees and costs of defending any actions or suits, including any appeals which may result from the use of the street area under this permit by providing evidence of insurance protecting the City of Portland, its officers. agents, and employees as follows: Bodily injury \$100,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, property damage \$50,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, said insurance to be kept in full force and effect at all times. This permit is automatically revoked without further action by the Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled, or for any other reason, becomes inoperative.
- (4) This permit is a burden upon the property and runs with the land and will require insurance with limits of coverage that will meet the maximum requirements for liability of a public body as set forth in O.R.S. No. 30.270 or as it may be required by subsequent amendment and naming the City, its officers, agents, and employees as additional insured.
- (5) That the plans for construction of the stairway be reviewed by the Bureaus of Fire, Planning, Police, and Traffic Engineering and their requirements be incorporated into the plans.
- (6) That the plans for the construction of the stairway and protective cover be approved by the Bureau of Buildings and the City Engineer.
- (7) The permittee shall reimburse the City for the cost of filing by the City Auditor of a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Records Division of Multhomah County.
- (8) The permittee shall pay the permit fee of \$10.00 required by Section 17.24.020 of the City Code.
- (9) The permittee shall obtain a street vacation petition and actively seek to vacate that portion of the dedicated street lying between the westerly property line of the property herein described and the back of the east sidewalk of N. Interstate Avenue.
- Section 2. This Ordinance will not become effective until the permittee has filed with the City Auditor a document which has been approved by the City Attorney accepting the terms and conditions hereof. This Ordinance shall be automatically revoked without further consideration by the Council if the terms and conditions are not accepted within sixty (60) calendar days of the passage of this Ordinance.
