
The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Exposition-Recreation Commission, 1401 N. Wheeler Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97227, through John Christison, General Manager, has requested permission to install, use and maintain a 4 inch electrical conduit and electrical lines in and under the sidewalk area on the west side of S.W. 18th Avenue south of the south line of S.W. Morrison Street.
- 2. The conduit and electrical lines are needed to upgrade the electrical needs of the Portland Civic Stadium resulting from the renovation project.
- 3. The Office of the Mayor agrees to the installation of the conduit and electrical lines in the sidewalk adjacent to the Portland Civic Stadium.
- 4. The plan for the conduit and electrical lines, attached to this Ordinance as "Exhibit A" has been approved by the City Engineer.
- 5. The granting of said permission, under certain conditions, will not be detrimental to the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A permit be granted to the Exposition-Recreation Commission, permittee, to install, use and maintain the conduit and electrical lines, described in Section 1-1 above and located as shown on the plan marked "Exhibit A", attached hereto and by reference made a part of this Ordinance, subject to the following conditions:
  - That the permittee will maintain the said conduit and electrical lines until such time as its removal shall in the opinion of the Council be in the public interest.
  - (2) The permittee shall pay the permit fee of \$83.25 required by Section 17.24.020 of the City Code.

(3) That the conduit and electrical lines are to be installed under the direction and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer, it being further provided that the cost for any repairs to said sidewalk area for settlement over said conduit shall be borne by the permittee.

- (4) If during construction under this permit, it becomes necessary or expedient to modify the location or the plan for the said conduit, the permittee shall first obtain the approval of the City Engineer on revised plans filed in duplicate with the City Engineer. One copy of the approved plan showing the change shall be filed by the City Engineer with the City Auditor to become a part of this Ordinance.
- (5) That the said conduit shall be installed in the sidewalk area in such a manner so as not to interfere with any existing pipes or lines therein.
- Section 2. This Ordinance shall not become effective until the permittee has filed with the City Auditor a document satisfactory to the City Attorney accepting the terms and conditions hereto.
- Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will result in an unnecessary hardship on the part of the applicant as to the status of the requested permit for installation of the conduit and electrical lines in the sidewalk area of S.W. 18th Avenue; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
