## ORDINANCE NO: 152872

An Ordinance authorizing the loan of a surplus ambulance stretcher from the Bureau of Fire to Portland Civic Theatre, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Civic Theatre requires the use of an ambulance stretcher for a public theatre production to be conducted from March 5, 1982 to April 24, 1982.
- 2. That such production will be of benefit to the citizens of Portland.
- 3. Chapter 5.36.030 of the Code of the City of Portland prohibits the gratuitous loan of personal property of the City without the express consent of Council.
- 4. The equipment to be loaned is surplus to the Fire Bureau and is not needed for emergency response.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge of the Bureau of Fire be authorized to gratuitously loan one (1) ambulance stretcher to Portland Civic Theatre for the period of March 1, 1982 to April 30, 1982.
- b. The Portland Civic Theatre shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, and employees free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property, including legal fees and costs of defending any actions or suits, including appeals, which may result from the loan of the surplus property by providing evidence of insurance protecting the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees as follows:

Bodily injury, \$100,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, and property damage \$50,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, or a single limit policy for \$300,000. The insurance shall be kept in full force and effect at all times.

## ORDINANCE No.

- Section 2. This ordinance will not become effective until the grantee has filed with the City Auditor a document accepting the terms and conditions hereof, and the evidence of insurance, each of which has been approved by the City Attorney.
- Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that there be no delay in authorization for the loan; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
