An Ordinance accepting a Bill of Sale from Gilbert Water District for water service lines and meters, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Areas in the Gilbert Water District have been annexed to the City of Portland.
- Said District, pursuant to the resolution of its Board of Commissioners, has executed a Bill of Sale from District conveying title to the City of Portland of water service lines and meters within the Gilbert Water District.
- Consideration for the transfer of the water service lines and meters to the City of Portland is the assumption by the City of the responsibility for maintenance of same.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a Bill of Sale from Gilbert Water District, attached to the Original only, marked Exhibit "A".
