

ORDINANCE NO. 152891

An Ordinance transferring \$18,600 within the Sewage Disposal Fund from General Operating Contingency to Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, for investigation of the Taulman Company and Weiss composting system, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the City, after several years of working toward a long-term solution for the disposal or utilization of wastewater sludges, has been unable to implement any of the alternatives selected.
2. That a new alternative has been proposed to the City that is less costly on a 20-year average annual basis.
3. That, in order for the City Engineer to recommend on the Taulman/Weiss composting system for long-term utilization of the City's wastewater sludges, an investigation needs to be conducted into the reliability and acceptance of this system and the financial status of the Taulman Company.
4. That the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering requires \$18,600 additional appropriation within its budget for investigation of the Taulman Company's financial status and investigation of the reliability and acceptance of the Weiss composting operations and their applications to Portland's sludge.
5. The additional appropriation should be provided by transfer from within the Sewage Disposal Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The 1981-82 budget is hereby amended to transfer \$18,600 within the Sewage Disposal Fund as follows:
