ORDINANCE NO. 152901

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to East Portland Jaycees to place a parade review stand on the west sidewalk of S.W. Broadway between S.W. Oak Street and S.W. Stark Street from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on March 17, 1982, at a fee of \$10.00, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The East Portland Jaycees have applied, through Lynn E. Jackson, P.O. Box 970, Portland, Oregon 97207, to place a parade review stand on the west sidewalk of S.W. Broadway between S.W. Oak Street and S.W. Stark Street on March 17, 1982 for the East Portland Jaycees St. Patrick's Day Parade.
2. The parade has been approved by the Mayor's Office.
3. The stand will be on the sidewalk from 10:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
4. The granting of this permission, under certain conditions, will not be detrimental to the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A revocable permit is hereby granted to East Portland Jaycees to place a parade review stand on the west sidewalk of S.W. Broadway between S.W. Oak Street and S.W. Stark Street from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on March 17, 1982, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) The permittee will maintain five (5) feet of clear sidewalk.
 - (2) This permit is revocable at any time and no expenditure of money or lapse of time or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland or to be held to give the permittee any vested or other right.
 - (3) This permit is for the use of the street area only and shall not exempt the permittee from obtaining any license or permit required by City Code or Ordinance for any act to be performed under this permit, nor shall this permit waive the provision of any City Code or Ordinance or the City Charter except as herein stated.
 - (4) The permittee shall obtain permission from the Benson Hotel and furnish a written copy of such to the City Auditor.

ORDINANCE No.

- (5) The time allowed for construction placement and removal of the stand shall be 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- (6) The permittee shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property, including legal fees and costs of defending any actions or suits, including any appeals which may result from the use of the street area under this permit by providing evidence of insurance protecting the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees as follows:
Bodily injury \$100,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, property damage \$50,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, said insurance to be kept in full force and effect at all times.
This permit is automatically revoked without further action by the Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled or, for any other reason, becomes inoperative.
- (7) The permittee shall submit plans of the stand to the City Engineer no later than March 10, 1982.
- (8) The permittee shall pay the fee of \$10.00 required by 17.24.020 of the City Code.


Section 2. This Ordinance will not become effective until the permittee has filed with the City Auditor both a document accepting the terms and conditions hereof, and the evidence of insurance, each of which has been approved by the City Attorney.

Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will result in an unnecessary hardship of uncertainty on the part of the applicant as to the status of the requested permit for placing the review stand; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
