ORDINANCE NO. 152502

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to Holy Redeemer School, to place a banner across N Portland Boulevard between N Vancouver Avenue and N Moore Avenue, from March 4, through March 15, 1982, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Holy Redeemer School has, through Janice Dillehay, 6446 N Moore Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97217, applied for permission to attach a banner to a supporting overhead cable across N Portland Boulevard between N Vancouver Avenue and N Moore Avenue, from March 4, through March 15, 1982.
- 2. The said banner is for the purpose of advertising a fund raising auction to be held on March 13, 1982.
- 3. That the granting of said permission under certain conditions, will not be detrimental to the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A revocable permit be granted to Holy Redeemer School, permittee, to place an overhead banner across N Portland Boulevard between N Vancouver Avenue and and N Moore Avenue, from March 4, through March 15, 1982, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) The banner must have a clearance of 18 feet above the roadway of the street and 10 feet above the sidewalk and comply with State Highway regulations governing such installations.
 - (2) Approval for use of utility poles and manner of securing and fastening overhead cables to the poles must be obtained from the utility companies involved.
 - (3) This permit is for the use of the street area only and shall not exempt the permittee from obtaining any license or permit required by City Code or Ordinance for any act to be performed under this permit, nor shall this permit waive the provision of any City Code or Ordinance or the City Charter except as herein stated.
 - (4) This permit is revocable at any time and no expenditure of money or lapse of time or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland or to be held to give the permittee any vested or other right.

- (5) The permittee shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property, including legal fees and costs of defending any actions or suits, including any appeals which may result from the use of the street area under this permit by providing evidence of insurance protecting the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees as follows: Bodily injury \$100,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, property damage \$50,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, said insurance to be kept in full force and effect at all times. This permit is automatically revoked without further action by the Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled or, for any other reason, becomes inoperative.
- Section 2. This Ordinance will not become effective until the permittee has filed with the City Auditor a document, which has been approved by the City Attorney, accepting the terms and conditions hereof. This Ordinance shall be automatically revoked without further consideration by the Council if the acceptance together with documents and fees required are not on file with the City Auditor within sixty (60) calendar days of the passage of this Ordinance.
- Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will result in an unnecessary hardship of uncertainty on the part of the applicant as to the status of the requested permit for hanging the banner; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
