## AMENDMENT No. 1 to INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT No. 30006889 FOR

the Use of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2018 Innovations in Community-Based Crime Reduction Program Grant Funds; FAIN No. 2018-BJ-BX-0001; Assistance Listing No. 16.817

This Amendment No. 1 amends Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) No. 30006889 dated the 22nd day of January 2020, by and between Portland State University, ("PSU"), a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, and the City of Portland, acting on behalf of its Police Bureau ("PPB"), a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, by and through their duly authorized representatives. This Amendment may refer to PSU and PPB individually as a "Party" or collectively as the "Parties."

This Amendment is authorized by City Ordinance No. TBD.

The Effective Date of this Amendment is October 1, 2021. The purpose of this Amendment is to extend the validity of the IGA and increase its not-to-exceed amount.

This IGA has never been amended:

The Parties agree to amend the IGA as follows:

- 1. The Term is extended from September 30, 2021, to **November 30,2022**, unless terminated sooner under the provisions of the IGA.
- 2. The IGA not-to-exceed amount of \$258,000 is increased by \$30,000 to a new total not-to-exceed amount of **\$288,000**. **Exhibit A**.

All other terms and conditions of the IGA remain unchanged by this Amendment and in full force and effect.

This Amendment may be signed in two (2) or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same instrument. The Parties agree that they may execute this Amendment by electronic means, including the use of electronic signatures.
