

ORDINANCE No. 152917

An Ordinance authorizing a contract with R & R Excavating Co., Inc., to furnish materials and labor for the Seawall Ship Connection facilities to the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That R & R Excavating Co., Inc., 12213 Silverton Road NE, Silverton, Oregon 97381, was the lowest responsible bidder for the Seawall Ship Connection facilities, for the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering.
2. Award of a contract to said bidder for completing said project has been recommended and approved by the Commissioner-in-charge.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Works and the Auditor hereby are authorized to execute a contract with the responsible bidder for the project described in Section 1 hereof, in accordance with plans and specifications filed with the Purchasing Agent on February 1, 1982.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1981-82 Budget, Sewage Disposal Fund, Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, Pump Station and Treatment Plant Design Division, RU 149, Object Code 630, Improvements, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this project will deprive ships anchored at the seawall from easy access to the City's sewer system during the coming Rose Festival season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
