

Annexation of territory to the City of Portland

A Boundary Description of a tract located in Section 1, 1N., 1E., W.M.

Beginning at the southeast corner of that tract of land recorded on March 24, 1945, in Book 918, at Page 105 of Multnomah County Deed Records, said point bearing S.4°42'17"W., 448.05 feet from the intersection of the center lines of Multnomah County Road No. 1167 and Multnomah County Road No. 1473; thence N.79°17'30"W., 636.68 feet to the southwest corner of said tract; thence N.03°15'30"E., a distance of 398 feet, more or less, to a point lying in the north right-of-way line of NE Marine Drive (County Road No. 1160); thence S.86°31'E., 670 feet, more or less, along said north right-of-way line, to the west line of a tract conveyed to Seattle First National Bank on June 4, 1974, in Book 1044, Page 341, Multnomah County Book of Records; thence N.04°17'30"E., along the west line of said tract and the extension thereof, a distance of 150 feet, more or less, to the high water line of the south channel of the Columbia River; thence easterly along said high water line, a distance of 1235 feet, more or less, to the east line of that tract of land deeded to George C. and Ruby H. Staples on March 2, 1962, in Book 2105, Page 72, Multnomah County Book of Deeds; thence S.04°17'30"W., 365 feet, more or less, following said east line and its southerly extension thereof to its intersection with the south line of that right-of-way line described in Book 2062, Page 307ff, recorded in the 1961 Multnomah County Book of Records; thence southwesterly following said south right-of-way line along the following described courses: S.89°51'47"W., 350 feet, more or less; thence on a curve to the left on a radius of 786.78 feet, with an included angle of 20°48'30", a distance of 285.74 feet; thence S.59°03'17"W., 68.83 feet; thence on a 6° curve to the right on a radius of 954.93 feet, with an included angle of 23°25', a distance of 390.28 feet; thence on a curve to the left on a radius of 361.86 feet, a distance of 254.63 feet to the most westerly corner of that tract of land owned by the Port of Portland and described as Tax Lot 36, Section 1, 1N., 1E., W.M.; thence N.87°(± 10°)W., 150 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, and excluding the following described parcel of land: Beginning at the southeast corner of that tract of land recorded on March 24, 1945, in Book 918, Page 105, Multnomah County Deed Records, said point bearing S.4°42'17"W., 448.05 feet from the intersection of the center lines of Multnomah County Road No. 1167 and Multnomah County Road No. 1473; thence bearing N.79°17'30"W. to a point lying on the west right-of-way line of said Road No. 1473 and the true point of beginning; thence following the described eight courses; N.79°17'30"W., 55.92 feet; thence on a curve to the left on a radius of 218 feet, with an included angle of 30°25'40", a distance of 115.77 feet; thence N.66°31'13"W., 475.80 feet; thence N.03°15'30"E., 63.32 feet; thence S.66°31'13"E., 201.59 feet; thence on a 6° curve to the left on a radius of 954.93 feet, with an included angle of 21°00'30", a distance of 350.14 feet; thence S.87°31'43"E., 76.08 feet to a point on the west line of said County Road; thence S.04°42'17"W., 177.35 feet to the true point of beginning.

ORDINANCE No. 152920

152920

An Ordinance fixing a public hearing for March 24, 1982, at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, on the question of withdrawal from Rose City Water District of Tax Lots 12, 13, 4, 30, 31, 34, 19, 20, 110 and Tax Lot 36 North of Slough, Section 1, T1N, R1E, W.M. annexed to the City of Portland, authorizing the City Auditor to publish and post notices and expend money therefor, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

1. Tax Lots 12, 13, 4, 30, 31, 34, 19, 20, 110 and Tax Lot 36 North of Slough, Section 1, T1N, R1E, W.M. has been annexed to the City by Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission Final Order No. 1712, effective May 21, 1981.
2. It is appropriate to withdraw said area from Rose City Water District pursuant to ORS 199.510(b), 222.520 and 222.524.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. A public hearing shall be held on March 24, 1982 at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, at which time objections shall be heard regarding the withdrawal from said district of the property described in Exhibit "A".
- b. The City Auditor is authorized to publish notice of the date, time, place and purpose of said hearing once each week for two successive weeks prior to the hearing in the City official newspaper, and shall cause notices of said hearing to be posted in four public places in the City for a like period.
- c. The City Auditor is authorized to expend money for such publication as may be needed, chargeable to the appropriation for such advertising.
- d. The City Auditor shall notify said district of said hearing.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the hearing must be held without undue delay on the question of withdrawal of said property from said district; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
