

ORDINANCE NO. 152924

An Ordinance accepting an Oregon Arts Commission grant in the amount of \$1,500 to be used for the Metropolitan Arts Commission's CityArts (MultiArts) program, increasing resources and requirements in the Federal/State Grants Fund and General Fund, transferring \$1,500 within the General Fund from Contingency and \$1,500 from Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures to the Metropolitan Arts Commission, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Metropolitan Arts Commission, with the help of an NEA Grant and matching funds from the City and County, has initiated a CityArts (MultiArts) program designed to increase the accessibility of the arts at a neighborhood level and to fund minority and ethnic projects.
2. Ordinance Number 152515 approved an application to the Oregon Arts Commission for a grant in the amount of \$1,500 to be used to enhance the Metropolitan Arts Commission's CityArts (MultiArts) program, contingent upon a 2:1 match.
3. The Oregon Arts Commission approved the grant application in the amount of \$1,500.
4. The City of Portland and Multnomah County each have provided assurance of matching funds not to exceed \$1,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Commissioner in Charge are hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City, an Oregon Arts Commission grant in the amount of \$1,500 to be used for the CityArts (MultiArts) program.
- b. The FY 1981-82 City Budget is hereby amended to include increases in appropriations in the amount of \$1,500; transferring \$1,500 within the General Fund from Contingency, and \$1,500 from Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures to the Metropolitan Arts Commission as follows:
