

ORDINANCE NO. 152931

An Ordinance transferring \$3,857 from Sewage Disposal Fund Contingency to the Fleet Operating Fund and transferring \$3,857 in appropriation from the Fleet Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Fleet Management for the purchase of a vehicle necessary for the Industrial Waste Program in the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, and declaring an emergency.

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The approved FY 81/82 Bureau of Sanitary Engineering budget authorizing the Industrial Waste Program inclusive of related fleet expense.
2. That a vehicle is necessary to allow collection of wastewater samples from industrial dischargers.
3. That the presently authorized vehicle was involved in an accident and is a total loss.
4. The wrecked vehicle is currently being replaced with a pool vehicle.
5. An assigned vehicle is included in the proposed FY 82/83 budget.
6. That an interfund transfer is necessary to purchase a vehicle for the Industrial Waste Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the following transfers of appropriation be affected:


