

Survey Results (so far)

- 476 responses as of Tuesday
- Most responses are from Brentwood-Darlington, and almost 75% are residents
- Almost 90% of respondents own their home, most (95%) are white

- Not as much interest/support for expanding home-based businesses








Survey Results (so far)

- Woodstock, 52nd and 72nd Avenues most important busy streets to improve
- Sidewalks, traffic calming most important focus for local streets
- More support for neighborhood greenways than bike lanes on busier streets

What should the plan focus be on busier streets?






