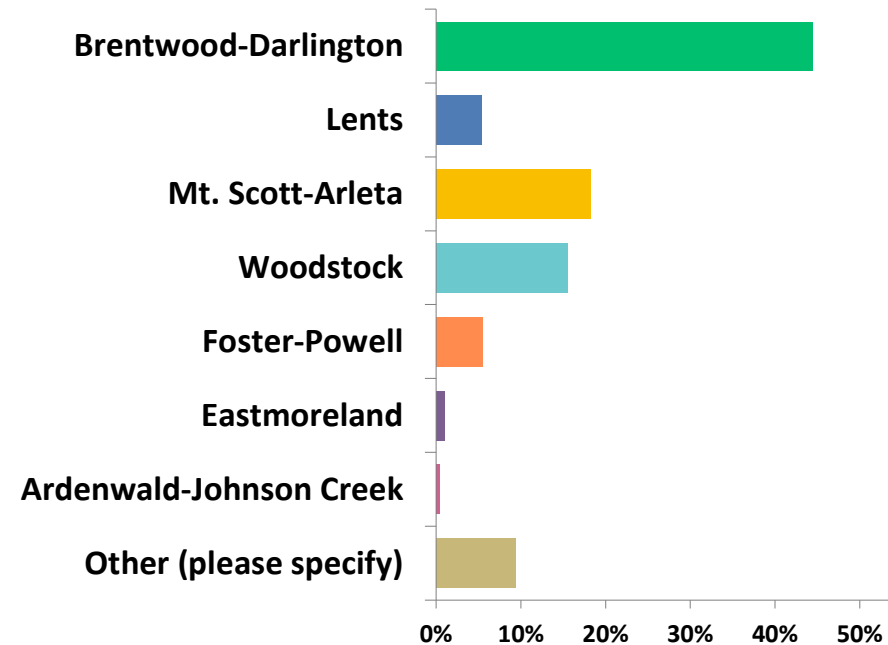

## Survey Results (so far)

- 476 responses as of Tuesday
- Most responses are from Brentwood-Darlington, and almost 75% are residents
- Almost 90% of respondents own their home, most (95%) are white

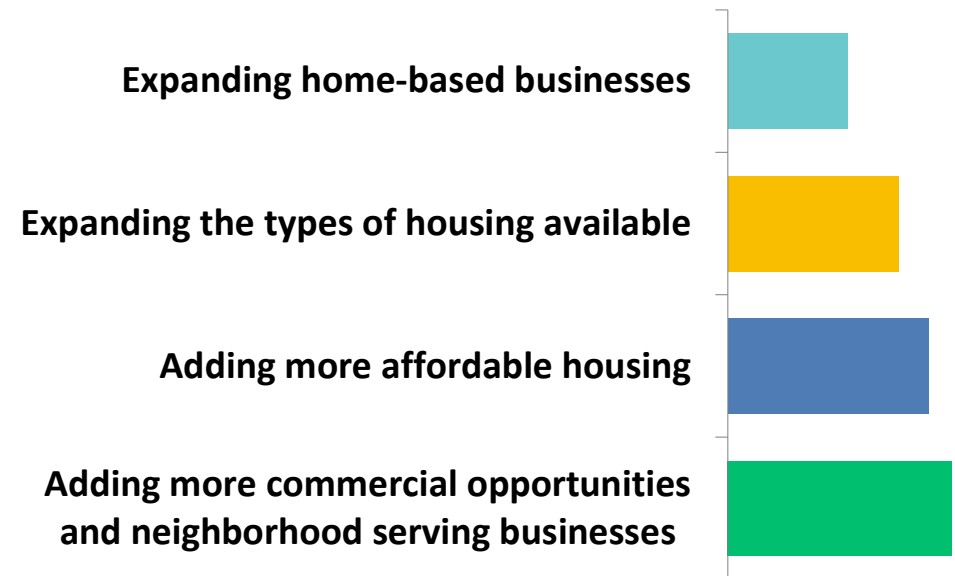

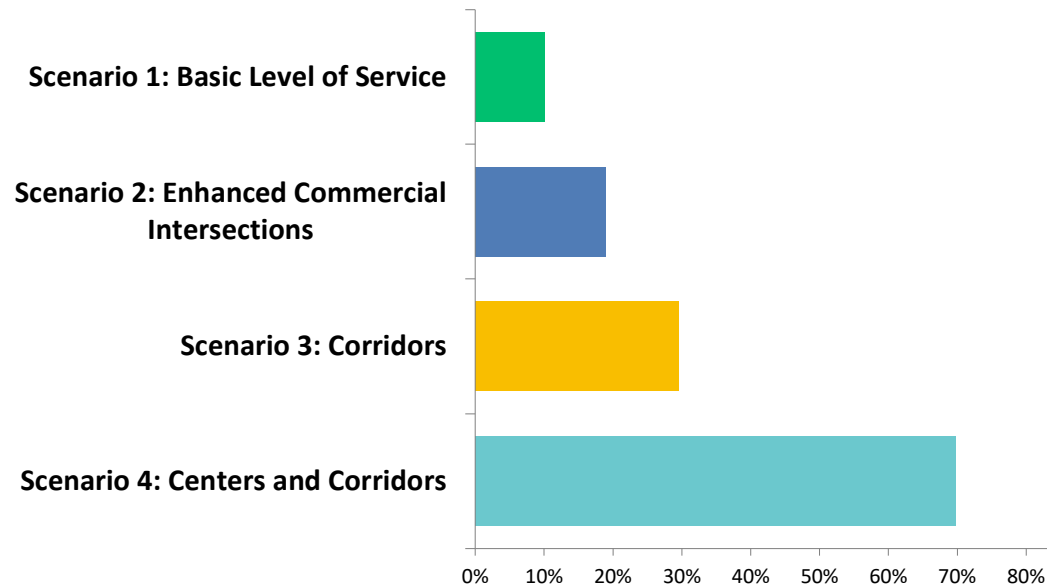

*Which scenario(s) do you feel are the most appropriate for the Lower SE Rising project area?*



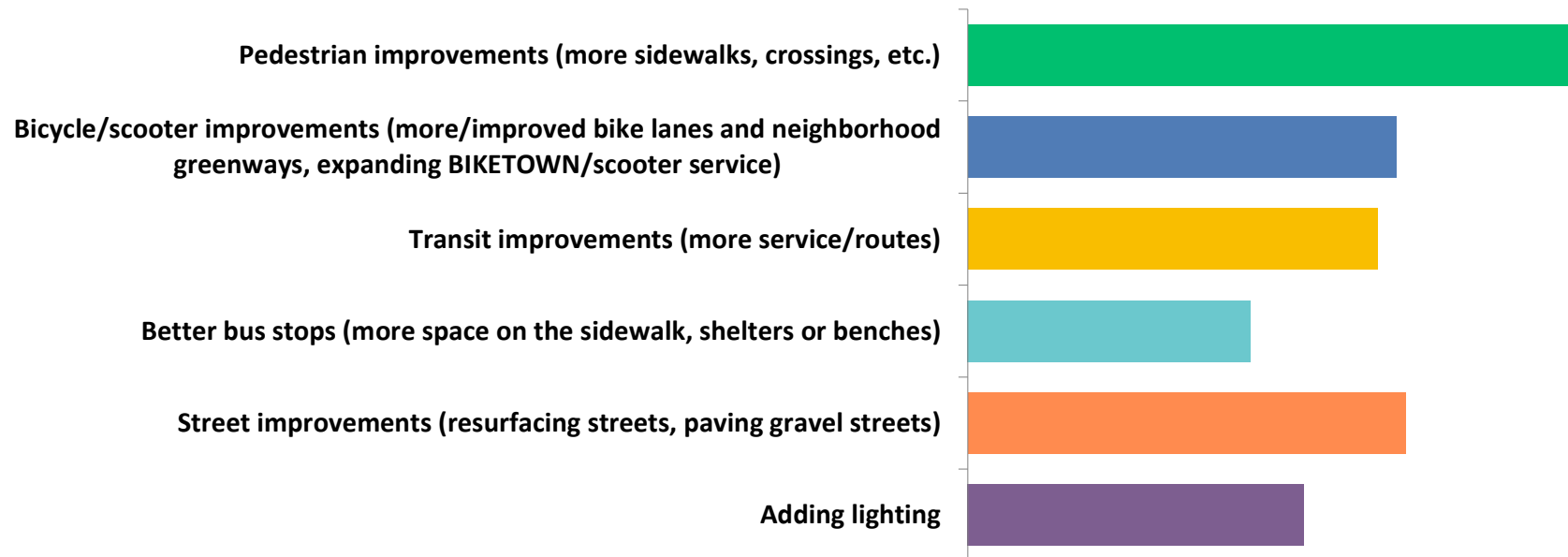

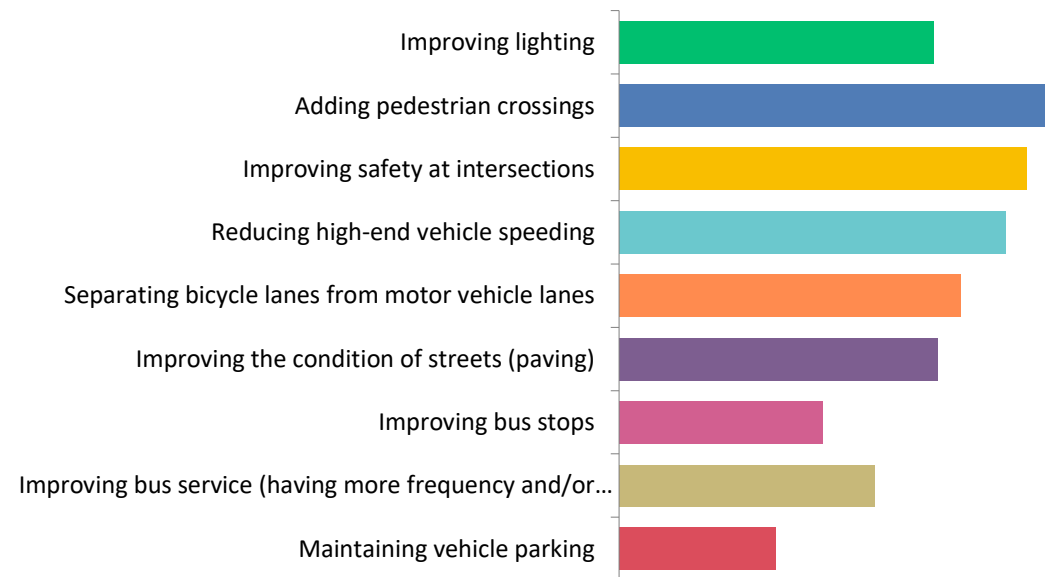

- Woodstock, 52<sup>nd</sup> and 72<sup>nd</sup> Avenues most important busy streets to improve
- Sidewalks, traffic calming most important focus for local streets
- More support for neighborhood greenways than bike lanes on busier streets

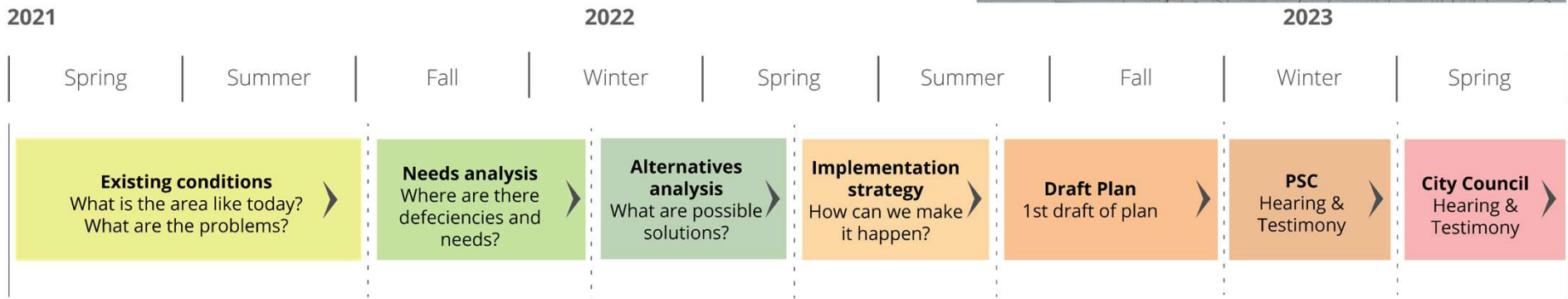
