

ORDINANCE No. 176117

- * Authorize Contract with Davis, Hibbitts & McCaig, Inc. for professional surveying of City households to provide information to be utilized by City Council in developing the FY 2002-03 budget. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 2. The Council finds:

1. The City Council desires to hear from Portland citizens their issues, concerns and priorities on service delivery in order to develop a budget which responds to the needs and desires of Portland residents.
2. The Bureau of Financial Planning requires professional services in the conduct of a City residents' telephone and comparisons survey, as well as public opinion and web site design consulting services in the development of the City's FY 2002-03 budget.
3. Davis, Hibbitts & McCaig, Inc. has been selected by the Bureau of Financial Planning through a formal consultant selection process based on their ability to perform the work within the established time frames.
4. The Bureau of Financial Planning's FY 2000-01 Budget includes appropriation for Your City, Your Choice activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute the Contract, attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants not to exceed \$50,500.

Section 2. The Council declared that an emergency exists because it is desirable to obtain citizen input in the development of the FY 2002-03 City Budget without delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
