An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving NE Mallory Avenue from the center line of NE Lombard Street to the north line of NE Russet Street, and declaring an emergency.

## THE CITY OF PORTLAND ORDAINS:

Section 1. That NE Mallory Avenue from the center line of NE Lombard Street to the north line of NE Russet Street, shall be improved as follows:

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that the cost of said that the cost of said improvement shall be assessed as pro-vided by the Charter and Ordinances of said City upon the property appoint and peculiarly benefited thereby, which property is hereby determined and declared to be all the lots, parts thereof and parcels of land with the dis-trict of said City described as follows: Beginning in the northwest corner of Lot 8. Block 6 of Love's addition thence easterly to the northeast corner of Lot 4. Block 7: of Love's addition thence south or y to the southeast corner of Lot 4. Block 7: of Love's addition, then western to the southwest corner of Lot 4. Block 7: of Love's addition, then western to the southwest corner of Lot 9. Block 6: of Love's addition, then western to the southwest corner of Lot 9. Block 6: of Love's addition, then western to the southwest corner of Lot 9. Block 6: of Love's addition, then western to the point of beginning. Classing & Grubbing. improvement shall be assessed at pro 15; Clearing & Grubbing 2nd: Concrete Excavation; 3rd: Sawcut Concrete; 4th: Constructing concrete sidewalk corner: Sth: Constructing concrete driveways, 6" thick: 6th: Constructing concrete curb: 7th: Skinpatching: 8th: Remove Warning sign from post: 9th: Constructing concrete steps 10th: Constructing new fence (4'chain link); 11th: Reconstructing fence (4' chain | link): 中的情報的 12th: Relocate street sign: 13th: Relocate Stop sign: 14th: Constructing inlets (single): 15th: Adjusting manholes; 16th: Improving the roadway with asphalt concrete Class "C". 1/2" thick, on aspatt concrete Class "B". 1/2" thick, on a crushed toack base 6" thick; 17th: By grading street to proper subgrade: That the estimated cost of said improvement in accordance with said. plans. specifications and estimates is \$28,649.34: that advertising costs, and a tee for engineering and superintend-ence will be added to the final cost in accordance with the provisions of the Code of the City of Portland;

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Section 2. That said improvement shall in all respects be done and completed in conformity with the plans and specifications therefor heretofore adopted by the Council and in conformity with the requirements of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon.

Section 3. The contractor or contractors for said improvement shall not dig up or disturb the surface of the street within the limits of said improvement for a greater distance than two blocks without having first obtained a permit to do so from the City Engineer.

Section 4. The contractor or contractors shall take entire charge of the work covered by the contract during the progress of the work and shall be responsible for any loss or accident resulting from carelessness or neglect, and the improvement shall be completed to the satisfaction of the Council of said City of Portland.

Section 5. The contractor or contractors shall complete said work covered by the contract by the time fixed

by the Council, to wit: <u>by Nov. 1, 1982</u>, and upon commencing said work shall continue the same without delay until completed unless the time for the completion of the same be extended by the Council, and the contract shall contain a provision that for each day required for the completion of the work covered by the contract after the expiration of said time there shall be forfeited by the contractor to the City the sum prescribed in the General Specifications adopted pursuant to Section 17.16.010 of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon.

Section 6. The contract shall also contain a stipulation to the effect that the person, firm or corporation to whom the contract is let shall look for payment only to the fund to be assessed upon the property liable to pay for said improvement and collected and paid into the City Treasury for that purpose, and that neither the contractor nor anyone claiming under him will require the City of Portland by any legal process or otherwise to pay the same out of any other fund.

Section 7. The Commissioner of Public Yorks is hereby directed to have the Maintenance Bureau perform the necessary work for the improvement provided by this Ordinance.

Section 8. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That said improvement should be made as soon as practicable; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
