ORDINANCE NO. 152981

An Ordinance authorizing amendments to the City's Three-Year Housing Assistance Plan and the FY 1981-82 Annual Housing Action Program, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- On April 11, 1979, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 147519 authorizing application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for a grant under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended for fiscal year 1979-80. Included under Part II of that application was the Three-Year Housing Assistance Plan.
- 2. The Three-Year Housing Assistance Plan established goals for the various types of housing assistance the City would attempt to provide over the three-year period beginning in FY 1979-80. In addition to the Three-Year Plan, Annual Housing Action Program goals are prepared for each year within the three-year period.
- 3. The three-year goals are established in part on the basis of a realistic distribution of goals by HUD programs based on past experience of HUD allocations and funding availability.
- 4. Due to shifts in HUD funding and allocations over the past two and one half years, elderly assisted housing goals in certain program areas have been achieved while goals in other elderly program areas have not received expected allocations of units or funds.
- 5. HUD cannot approve funding for a project if no goals remain for that particular elderly housing program type, even though ample needs and goals have been set out for elderly housing in general.
- 6. HUD is in the process of changing the Housing Assistance Plan process and has extended the time period covered by the present Housing Assistance Plan until October 1, 1982.
- 7. It is in the public interest to amend the Three-Year Housing Assistance Plan by shifting established goals from those program categories which have not received sufficient funding to meet City goals to those program categories for which funding is now available; to increase the goals to reflect the extended
