

ORDINANCE No. 152983

An Ordinance transferring \$23,000 within the Parking Facilities Operating Fund from General Operating Contingency to the Capital Outlay budget of the Portland Auto Port, for security modifications related to the storage of City-owned vehicles, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That one floor of the Auto Port should be secured for the storage of City vehicles currently parked in commercial lots and garages throughout downtown.
2. That the security measures will consist of the installation of gates, overhead doors, and related equipment.
3. That \$23,000 is available within the Parking Facilities Operating Fund, and appropriations in that amount should be transferred to the operating budget of the Auto Port so that these improvements can be completed prior to the occupancy of The Portland Building.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. Appropriations are transferred as follows:


