

SUPPLEMENTAL CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT

(Supplemental to Contract No. 19668)

This Supplemental Agreement is between the City of Portland, Oregon (City) and George L. Page (Consultant).

Recitals:

- 1. In Contract No. 19668, between City and Consultant, Consultant agreed to provide certain services to City's Municipal Cable Advisory Committee (MCAC).
- 2. Cablesystems Pacific has proposed to City a revision of Cablesystem's eastside cable television system that will integrate the institutional system into the residential A-2 cable.
- 3. The Cable Regulatory Commission (CRC) wishes to have Consultant review Cablesystems' proposal and report to CRC on his review.
- 4. Consultant can provide the needed services within the compensation limit of Contract No.19668.

AGREEMENT:

- 1. In addition to the services to be provided to MCAC under Contract No. 19668, Consultant shall provide the following services to CRC:
 - a. Review the City's eastside cable television Request for Proposals and franchise award process to identify the factors which caused City and Cablesystems to feel using a third cable for the institutional network was desirable at that time.
 - b. Assess operational and technological developments between the time of the franchise award and now which may have an effect on the desirability of a third cable for the institutional network.
 - c. Review the questions posed in the February 11, 1982 memorandum from Don Weidner to CRC regarding Cablesystems Pacific's Proposed Integration of Institutional System on Residential A-2 Cable to determine if those questions

cover all major areas of concern in the possible integration of institutional and residential cable services.

- d. Review Cablesystems' February 16 presentation to CRC on network integration to determine completeness and relevancy and to see whether Cablesystems' information suggests other pertinent factors to be reviewed by CRC.
 - e. Review cable industry trade publications and reports for current information on technical and operational aspects of integration.
 - f. Make inquiries of comparable size jurisdictions to determine if similar integrations have been considered.
 - g. Make a written report to CRC no later than April 13, 1982, giving his findings, evaluation and professional recommendation on the advantages, disadvantages, capabilities and reliability of Cablesystems' proposed network integration, especially in comparison to the company's original cable franchise proposal.
2. The services described in Section 1 shall be deemed to be part of the services to be provided by Consultant under Contract No. 19668. All of the services under this Supplemental Agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Sections 2 through 8 of Contract No. 19668, including without limitation the total compensation limit contained in Section 5, except that for purposes of services under this Supplemental Agreement, references to Section 1 of Contract No. 19668 shall be deemed to be references to Section 1 of this Supplemental Agreement and references to MCAC shall be deemed to be references to CRC.

ORDINANCE No. 152992

An ordinance authorizing a Supplemental Consultant Services Agreement to Contract # 19668, for George L. Page to provide expert services to the Cable Regulatory Commission, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In Contract No. 19668 between City and Consultant, Consultant agreed to provide certain services to City's Municipal Cable Advisory Committee (MCAC).
2. Cablesystems Pacific has proposed to City a revision of Cablesystems' eastside cable television system that will integrate the institutional system into the residential A-2 cable.
3. The Cable Regulatory Commission (CRC) wishes to have Consultant review Cablesystems' proposal and report to CRC on his review.
4. Consultant can provide the needed services within the compensation limit of Contract No. 19668.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and the Auditor are authorized to enter into a supplemental Consultant Services Agreement with George L. Page substantially in accordance with the form of agreement attached to this ordinance.
- b. Warrants in payment of services provided under the Agreement shall be charged to BUC 30000013:210.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists, in that it is essential to commence the expert services provided for as soon as possible; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect after its passage by the Council.
