

ORDINANCE NO. **152993**

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to sign a Purchase Order as a contract with Continental Systems, Inc. 6400 SW Canyon Court, Portland, Oregon 97221 for a CPT 6100 Word Processor System for the Bureau of Police in the amount of \$49,546.75 without advertising for bids, authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Police requires a Word Processing System.
2. After an extensive study of needs by the Bureau of Police it has been found that no other product of equal value, utility or merit is available for their purposes.
3. The Bureau of Police conferred with the Director of the Bureau of Computer Services and he concurs this is the only vendor that satisfies the Bureau's needs.
4. This purchase has been reviewed by the Purchasing Agent and he concurs with the Director of the Bureau of Computer Services and approves the purchase. It is therefore in the public interest for Continental Systems, Inc. to provide the necessary materials and services as set forth above at the cost of \$49,546.75 without advertising for bids.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall sign a Purchase Order to serve as a contract with Continental System, Inc. 6400 SW Canyon Court, Portland, Oregon 97221 for the item mentioned in Section 1 for the total amount of \$49,546.75 without advertising for bids. The Purchase Order shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver a warrant chargeable to the 1981-82 budget, General Fund, Bureau of Police, Detective Division, 10900018,640, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase may result in additional expense, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after it's passage by the Council.
