

## ORDINANCE NO. 153001

An Ordinance transferring \$5,240 within the General Fund from Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures, to the Bureau of Fire, Prevention Division, in payment for a fire safety watch for the Evergreen Apartments, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

1. That the City of Portland Fire Marshal found the Evergreen Apartments located at 1920 N.W. 26th, to present an imminent fire hazard to the occupants of that building;
2. That on February 11, 1982, Judge Patrick Dooley of the Circuit Court, 4th Judicial District, ordered the Fire Marshal to provide a 24-hour fire safety watch for the Evergreen Apartments for the protection of the occupants;
3. That the Fire Bureau hired Jones Security Patrol to provide a 24-hour safety watch from February 12 to March 28, 1982 at a cost of \$5,240;
4. That the Fire Bureau, in accordance with the Code of the City of Portland, Section 31.16.030, will bill the owners of the Evergreen Apartments, currently in receivership, for reimbursement to the City of the costs of the patrol;
5. That the Fire Bureau, Prevention Division requires an increased appropriation of \$5,240 in BUC #12700016, L.I. 260, to cover payment to Jones Security Patrol;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City of Portland FY 1981-82 Budget is amended as follows:


**ORDINANCE No.**
