**ORDINANCE No. 153022**

An Ordinance authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant totaling \$100.00, payable to Michael W. Corrie, as a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of an individual stealing monies from parking meters, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That Michael W. Corrie submitted information and assistance in the arrest and conviction of Harold Schwartzkoff on second degree theft and possession of burglary tool charges involving theft from parking meters in incidences on March 8, 1981.
2. That under Section 16.36.180(d), the Code of the City of Portland, the City offers a reward of \$100.00 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person tampering with or stealing from parking meters.
3. That Harold Schwartzkoff was found guilty on February 2, 1982, of offenses including second degree theft and possession of burglary tools involving theft from parking meters.
4. That Michael W. Corrie is entitled to the reward as recommended by the City Traffic Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver a warrant totaling \$100.00. Said warrant to be charged to the appropriation Rewards, BUC #40100164- Object Code 490, to be paid to and delivered as follows: Michael W. Corrie, c/o The Oregonian Publishing Company, 1320 S.W. Broadway St., Portland, OR 97201.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the preservation of the cooperation between citizens and law enforcement personnel should be maintained, and the financial obligations of the City should be paid without undue delay; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
