# ORDINANCE NO. 153067

An Ordinance authorizing the transfer of \$135,250 from the Workers' Compensation Operating Fund to the following funds: Sewage Disposal, Water, Exposition-Recreation/Memorial Coliseum, Central Services Operating, Fleet Operating, and Golf, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Workers' Compensation Operating Fund maintains reserves on behalf of those City funds that support employees covered by workers' compensation.
- A desired level of reserves has been determined for each such fund, primarily based upon the claims history of bureaus within the fund. The sum of those reserves is the City's workers' compensation reserve and meets or exceeds professional actuarial recommendations.
- 3. The reserves for certain funds exceed the desired level and it is proper to refund those excess amounts.
- 4. The excess reserves result from a combination of three factors: effective claims management by the Bureau of Risk Management, cooperative efforts by bureaus to reduce losses, and accrued interest to the fund balances.
- 5. The Commissioner of Public Safety recommends these refunds be made at this time.

### NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

a. The amount of \$135,250 is transferred from the Workers' Compensation Operating Fund to various other funds according to the following schedule:
