#### ORDINANCE NO. 153117

An Ordinance amending Contract No. 19514 with Loomis Armored Car Service, Inc., to extend the contract from July 1, 1982 through the fiscal year 1982-83, for services to the Water Bureau, increasing the monthly contract payments to \$226.00, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, providing for acceptance of ordinance by Contractor and by Surety, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On July 1, 1981, the City entered into Contract No. 19514 with Loomis Armored Car Service, Inc., a Nevada corporation, for furnishing armored car service to the Water Bureau for pickup and delivery of deposits to designated banks.
- 2. The Administrator of the Water Bureau has recommended extending Contract No. 19514 through the 1982-83 fiscal year, and an increase of monthly charges to \$226.00.
- 3. Said recommendations have been approved by the Commissioner-in-Charge of the Water Bureau, and extending Contract No. 19514 with said increase of monthly charges should be authorized.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Contract No. 19514 with Loomis Armored Car Service, Inc., for furnishing armored car pickup and delivery services hereby is extended for the fiscal year 1982-83, commencing July 1, 1982, with monthly charges to the Water Bureau in the sum of \$226.00, and with all other terms and provisions of said contract to remain in full force and effect.
- Section 2. The Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants pursuant to the terms of the contract authorized and extended hereinabove, warrants in payment for services to the Water Bureau to be charged to the Water Fund, BUC No. 18300010, Project 1503, Object Code 260, 1982-83 Budget, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

# ORDINANCE No.

- Section 3. This ordinance shall be an effective extension and amendment of Contract No. 19514 as set forth in Section 1 hereof upon written acceptance of this ordinance in form approved by the City Attorney, by Loomis Armored Car Service, Inc., and by the Surety on said Company's performance bond, and with evidence of insurance coverage as provided in said contract.
- Section 4. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in extending the contract may result in additional expense and may unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of the contract; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
