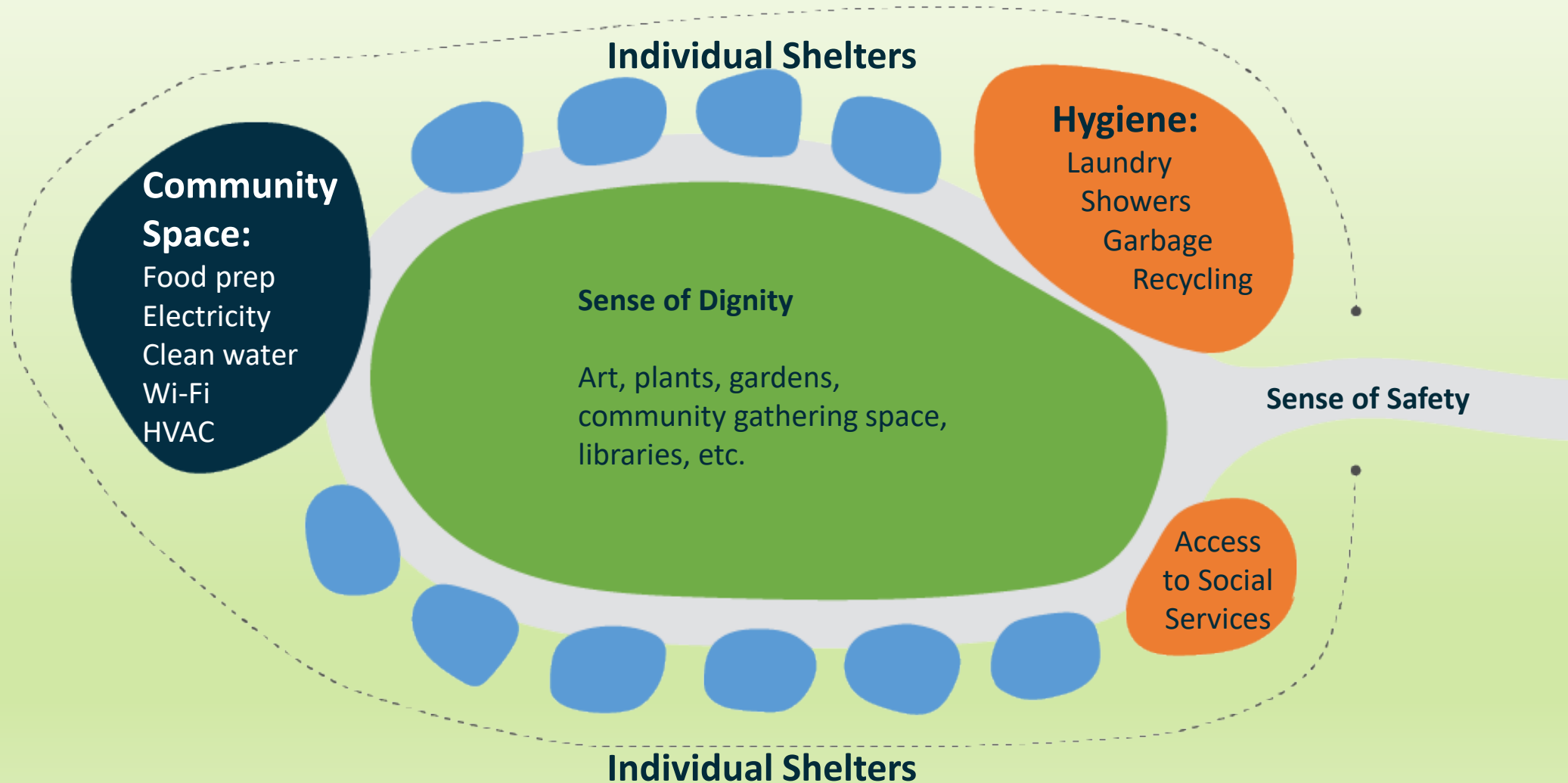

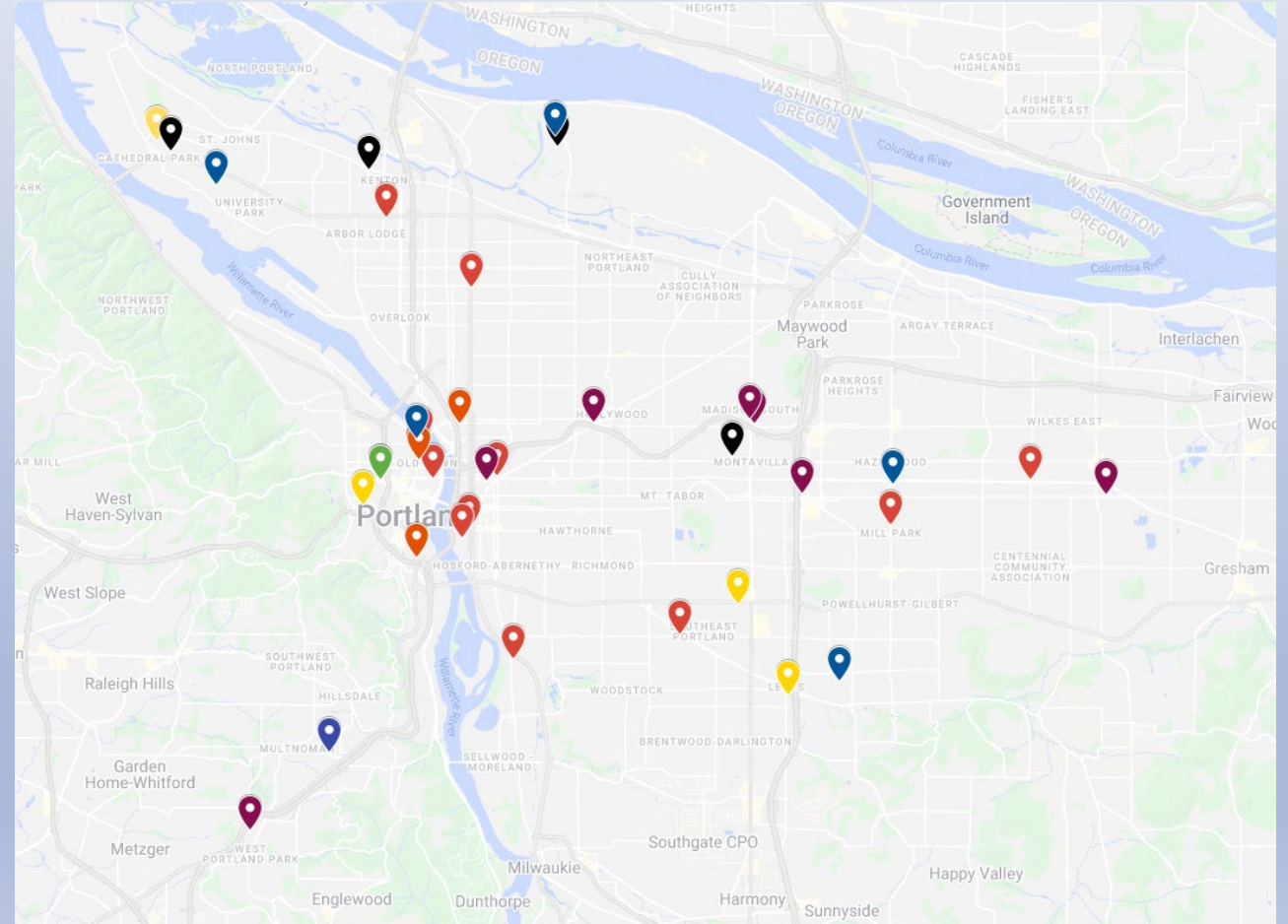
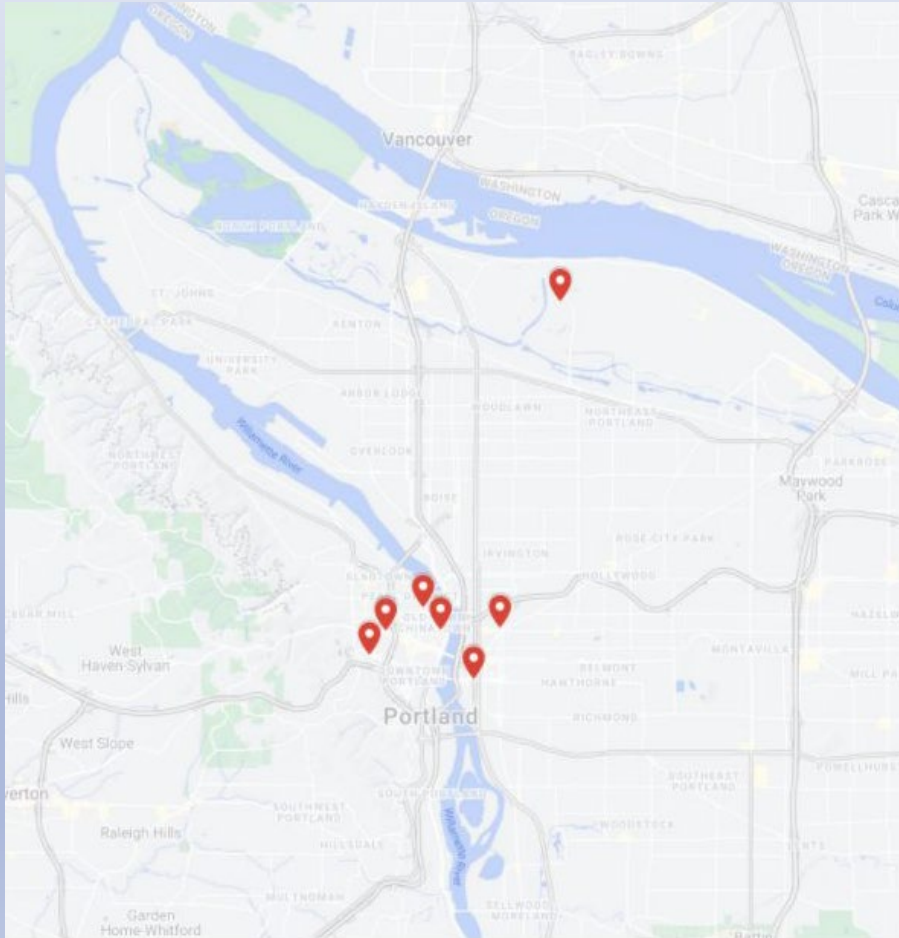

(pre-Emergency Declaration)

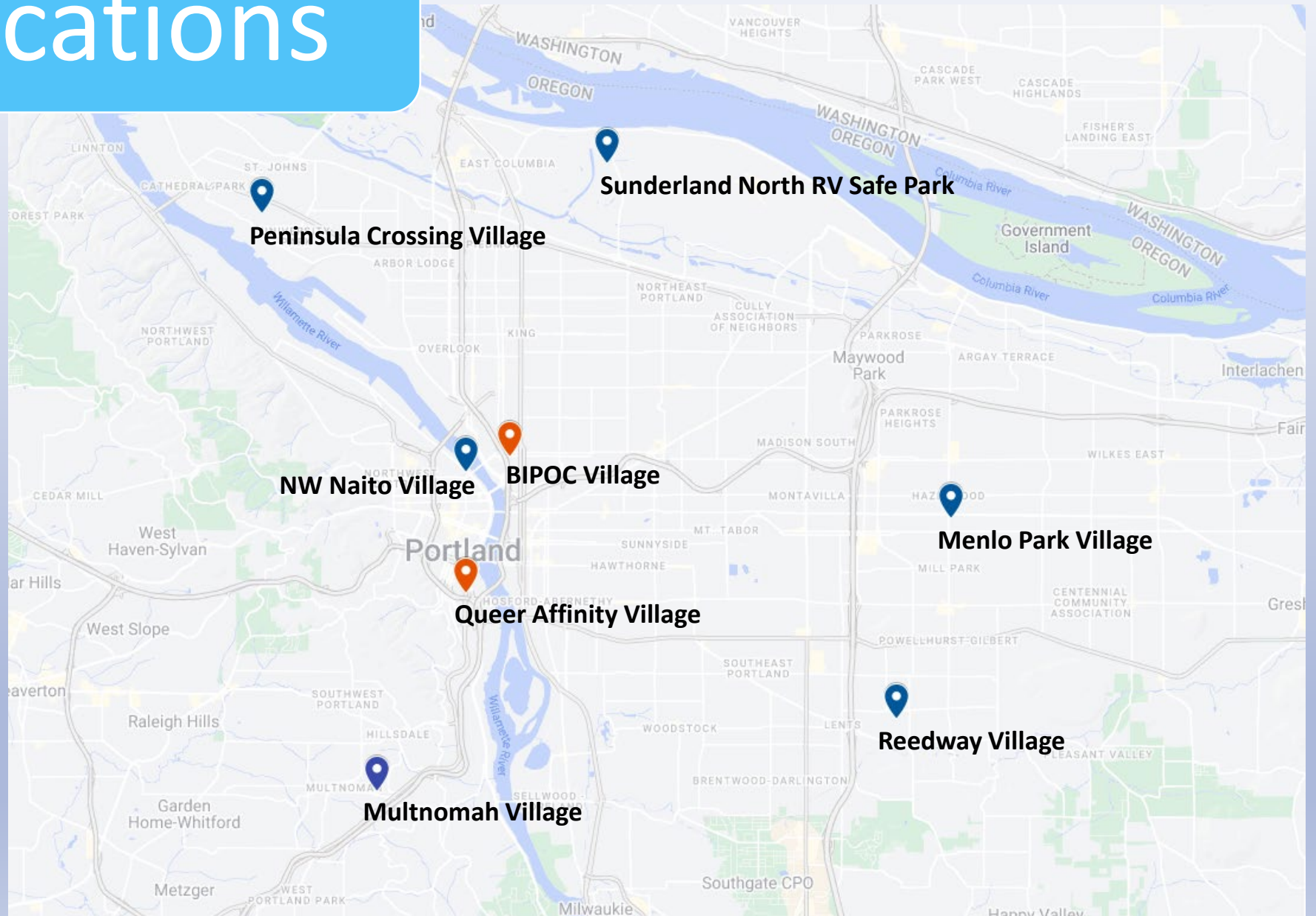

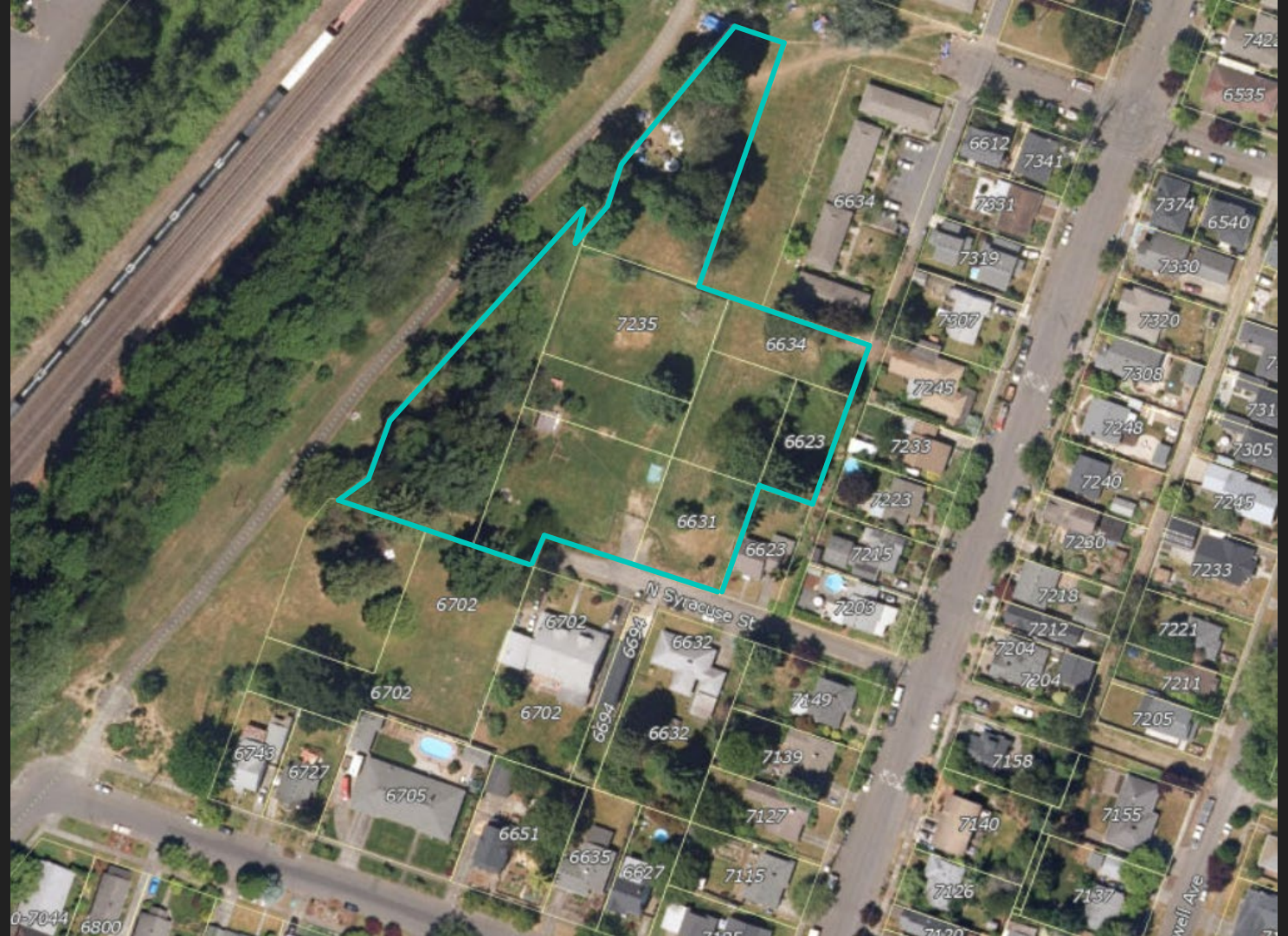
