- MEP Systems are near or at the end of their useful lives
- Historic Integrity needs to be maintained

- Resolution to complete the project




Why are we hiring an Owners Rep?


Project Phases

- Short list issued by November 20th
- Interviews December 4th-8th

- Contract executed by February 2nd
- First deliverable to review and finalize the designbuild-relocate RFP on February 24th, 2016




