

- **Orange Line 2017**
- **Division Transit & Future Better Bus Projects**

Division Transit - Corridor Map



- Improved, frequent bus service
- New 42 stations total; 35 in Portland
- More than 70% of transit users will have service near current stop
- 95% of existing riders will have service within 3 blocks of current stop

- Completing final fiber, signals and striping work
- Coordinating with Outer Division Multi-Modal Safety Project

Division Transit Improvements

- Enhanced Bus stations environments
- Reinforce (when possible) existing furnishing and frontage zones
- Improved lighting, safety, accessibility & connectivity

Division Transit Improvements

- Improved pedestrian environments
- Street trees, stormwater & landscaping
- Set stage for future improvements & economic development opportunities

Design Follow-up

- Implemented DRC & Community Preferred "Frames Shelter" Design
- Minor design refinements to station platforms, shelters & cabinets
- Various field adjustments










Bus Station Marker
