## **Memorandum of Understanding**

The Parties to this Letter of Agreement (Agreement) are the City of Portland (the City), on behalf of Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) and the Portland Fire Fighters' Association, IAFF Local 43 (PFFA or Union), (collectively, the Parties).

## Background

- 1. The City and the Union are parties to a collective bargaining agreement effective July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2023 (the CBA)
- 2. The Union is the sole collective bargaining representative on behalf of employees working in classifications listed in Schedule A of the CBA.
- 3. On or around December 17, 2021, the parties entered into a Letter of Agreement to hire Lateral Firefighters. A Lateral Firefighter is defined as a Firefighter with a minimum of two (2) years paid professional experience as a firefighter with a fire agency outside of PF&R.
- 4. Upon hire, Lateral Firefighter Recruits go through a three-phase training program.
- 5. While in the Phase III of training, Lateral Firefighters are assigned to Field Training Officers (FTOs).
- 6. The City and Union have an interest to incentivize the rate of pay for employees working in an FTO capacity.

## Agreement

- 1. Firefighters in Phase III will be assigned to designated training stations.
- 2. Permanently assigned members will have priority to be detailed back to their home station for any vacancies that occur.
- 3. Each identified training station will have up to three designated FTOs per Lateral Firefighter in Phase III.
- 4. While working as an FTO, the member will receive a 6% premium on their base wage.
- 5. This Agreement shall remain in place from October 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023. This Agreement shall not set any precedent for any purpose.
