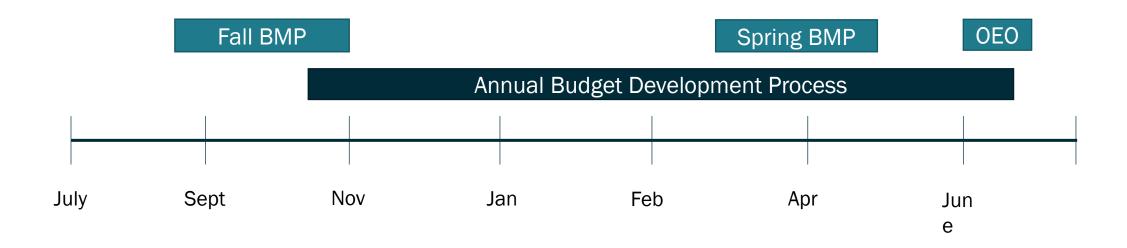

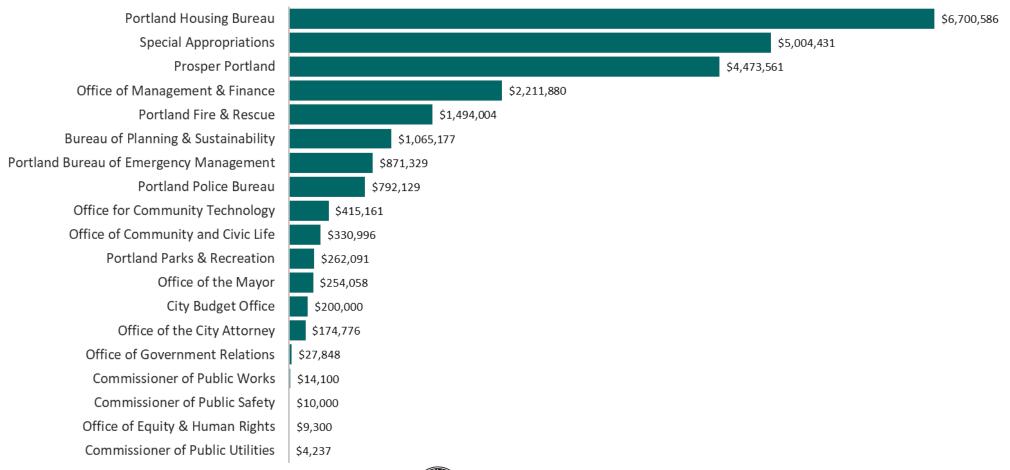


2022 Technical Fall BMP Adjustments



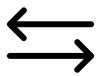
Encumbrance Carryovers

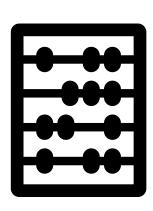
