My name is Leo Lawyer and I am a painting contractor based in Portland, OR. My wife is a commercial designer and works on SE 13th and Belmont. For the past year and a half she has had to dodge rubbish, human feces, urine, vomit, and passed-out housed and unhoused people on her way along the sidewalk to work. She is in constant fear of being assaulted from drug dealers and users, and keeps a vice grip on bear mace daily on her walk to and from her car as she arrives and departs work.

I am fairly confident you will hear from other Portlanders who have the same daily experiences, and it makes me so sad that our once fair city has deteriorated in this way. I do feel recent efforts to clean up graffiti and homeless camps have improved the overall aesthetics of Portland, but I don't think it is enough. Please continue to use tax-payer funds to continue the work you are currently engaged in, and expand those efforts to support law enforcement and they do their best to curtail open-air drug use and distribution.

I never imagined as a college student at PSU, earning a BA and an MS while taking public transit that I would witness the lawlessness and destruction we have endured over the past five to six years to our public art, businesses, homes, streets, bridges, etc., but I do see hope in the efforts to improve our livability.

Lastly, I truly feel people vote with their feet, and my family does as well. As my 15 year-old daughter matures and makes her way in this world, and my 13 year-old twin sons expand their views of what their future looks like, I can attest they do not like what they see in their daily travels.
