RESOLVED: That the Council of the City of Portland, Oregon, deems it expedient and purposes to construct a water main in East Sixteenth Street from a proposed main in Holgate Street to a main in Powell Street of cast iron pipe of eight inches clear inside diameter with all necessary gates, gate chambers, hydrants, tees and crosses.

Said water main to be constructed in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Portland and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer, filed in the office of the Auditor of the City of Portland on the 26th day of July, 1910, endorsed: "City Engineer's plans and specifications for water main in East 16th Street from Powell Street to Holgate Street and the estimates of the work to be done and the probable total cost thereof."

The cost of said water main to be assessed as provided by the City Charter upon the property specially and peculiarly benefited thereby and which is hereby declared to be all the lots, parts thereof and parcels of land lying within the district bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the northwest corner of lot 1 block 1 Smith's Subdivision and Addition to East Portland, thence south along the west line of said lot 1 and its prolongation south to the north line of Frederick Street, thence southwesterly to a point in the south line of Frederick Street 100 feet west of the west line of East 16th Street, thence south parallel with the west line of East 16th Street to the north line of Holgate Street, thence east along the north line of Holgate Street to a point 100 feet east of the east line of East 16th Street thence north parallel with the east line of East 16th Street to the south line of Frederick Street, thence northeasterly to a point in the north line of Frederick Street 120 feet east of the east line of East 16th Street, thence north 100 feet, thence east to the center line of the Oregon and California Railroad Company's right of way, thence northwesterly along the center line of said right of way to the south line of Powell Street, thence westerly along the southerly line of Powell Street to the place of beginning.

The City Engineer's estimate of the probable total cost for the construction of said water main is \$6,559.82

The plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer for the construction of said water main are hereby adopted.

RESOLVED: That the Auditor of the City of Portland be and he is hereby directed to give notice of the proposed construction of said water main as provided by the City Charter.
