WHEREAS, in the matter of the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of UNION AVENUE from its southerly terminus at Clinton street to a line 50 feet south of and parallel to the south line of Clinton street, extended west, the full amount necessary to pay the damages awarded and the cost of engineering et cetera has been paid into the City Treasury and warrants drawn and ready for delivery to parties entitled thereto, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Union avenue from its southerly terminus at Clinton street to a line 50 feet south of and parallel to the south line of Clinton street, extended west, be and the same is hereby declared opened, laid out and established as a city street, as provided by Ordinance No. 29553 adopting the report of the City Engineer.
