

## RESOLUTION NO. 9843

WHEREAS, in the matter of the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Bancroft Terrace in the City of Portland by relocating Bancroft Terrace and South Terrace in "The Cove" and extending said relocation easterly to Sixth Street near Bancroft Avenue and southerly to a connection with Terwilliger Boulevard about 125 feet west of Sixth Street; the full amount necessary to pay the damages awarded and the cost of engineering etc has been paid into the City Treasury and warrants drawn and ready for delivery to parties entitled thereto,

## THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That Bancroft Terrace in the City of Portland by relocating Bancroft Terrace and South Terrace in "The Cove" and extending said relocation easterly to Sixth Street near Bancroft Avenue and Southerly to a connection with Terwilliger Boulevard about 125 feet west of Sixth Street; be and the same is hereby declared opened, laid out and established as a city street, as provided by Ordinance No.. 32447.
