RESOLUTION NO. 11230 -2

WHEREAS, on the 4th day of March, 1920, the Engineer of the City of Portland, Oregon, in compliance with Resolution No. 10845 of the Council, filed in the office of the Auditor plans, specifications and estimates for the IMPROVEMENT of WYGANT STREET, from the east line of Delaware Avenue to the west line of Denver Avenue;

be it

RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Portland, Oregon, that said plans, specifications and estimates are found satisfactory and the same are hereby approved; that the Council does hereby declare its intention and purpose of making said improvement, which is described as follows:

- 1st: By grading said street to the proper subgrade;
- 2nd: By constructing asphalt or concrete sidewalks, as shall be hereafter determined by the Council;
- 3rd: By constructing concrete curbs;
- 4th: By tearing out old concrete curbs for driveways;
- 5th: By constructing concrete driveways;
- 6th: By laying wood headers;
- 7th: By constructing inlets;
- 8th: By laying cement or vitrified pipe for surface drain, as shall be hereafter determined by the Council;
- 9th: By paving the roadway of said street, full width, with either Asphaltic Concrete Pavement #1 on Crushed Rock Base, Asphaltic Concrete Pavement #2 on Crushed Rock Base, Concrete Pavement #1 or Concrete Pavement #3, as shall be hereafter determined by the Council.

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of said City of Portland and the plans and specifications covering the same, and the contractor shall agree to perform all of the work provided for under this resolution in such good, skillful and substantial manner that no repairs shall be required to said improvement for a period of five years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the time for completing said improvement be and is hereby fixed at one hundred twenty days from the date of the passage of the time and manner ordinance by the Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council does hereby determine the boundaries of the district benefited and to be assessed for such improvement to be as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east line of Delaware Avenue, 100 feet south of the south line of Wygant Street; thence north along the east line of Delaware Avenue to a point 100 feet north of the north line of Wygant Street; thence east, parallel to the north line of Wygant Street to the west line of Denver Avenue; thence south along the west line of Denver Avenue to a point 100 feet south of the south line of Wygant Street; thence west to the place of beginning.
