RESOLUTION No. 14155

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Portland deems it expedient

To widen and extend Burnside Street from the westerly harbor line of the Willamette River to the east line of Second Street by appropriating fifty-five (55) feet on each side of a line drawn from the intersection of the center-line of Burnside Street and the east line of Second Street to the intersection of the center-line of East Burnside Street and the west line of Union Avenue; also the widening of Burnside Street from the west line of Second Street to the east line of Third Street by appropriating twenty-five (25) feet from each side thereof, including additional triangular widenings at the northeast and southeast corners of Third and Burnside Streets, and the north east and southeast corners of Second and Burnside Streets, in the City of Portland, Oregon, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to make a survey and plat of the same and a written report thereon as provided by the City Charter.
