WHEREAS, in the matter of the proposed opening, laying out and establishing of Lownsdale street 15 feet wide from the northeasterly line of Myrtle Street to an extension of the northeasterly line of Clifton Street and Clifton Street 60 feet wide from its terminus at the southeasterly line of Block 300, Portland extended to a connection with the proposed extension and opening of Lownsdale Street in the City of Portland, Oregon, the full amount necessary to pay the damages has been paid into the City Treasury and warrants drawn and ready for delivery to parties entitled thereto, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED. That Lownsdale Street 15 feet wide from the northeasterly line of Myrtle Street to an extension of the northeasterly line of Clifton Street, and Clifton Street 60 feet wide from its terminus at the southeasterly line of Block 500, Portland, extended, to a connection with the proposed extension and opening of Lownsdale Street, in the City of Portland, Oregon, be and the same are hereby declared opened, laid out and established as city streets as provided by Ordinance No. 37218 adopting the report of the City Engineer, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED. That the City Engineer be and he is hereby instructed to record with the County Clerk of Multnomah County, Oregon, within ninety days after the adoption of this resolution a copy of the resolution and a map of said street extension.
