


Resolution No. 17009

WHEREAS, in the matter of the proposed opening, laying-out and establishing of East 17th Street, from a line 134.25 feet south of the south line of South Avenue to a line 125.82 feet north of the north line of Harold Avenue, in the City of Portland, Oregon, the full amount necessary to pay the damages has been paid into the City Treasury and warrants drawn and ready for delivery to parties entitled thereto, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that East 17th Street, from a line 134.25 feet south of the south line of South Avenue to a line 125.82 feet north of the north line of Harold Avenue, in the City of Portland, Oregon, be and the same is hereby declared opened, laid out and established as city street as provided by Ordinance No. 49070, adopting the report of the City Engineer, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Engineer be and he is hereby instructed to record with the County Clerk of Multnomah County, Oregon, within ninety days after the adoption of this resolution a copy of the resolution and a map of said street extension.
