WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Portland deems it expedient to widen East Glisan Street, from the east line of East 16th Street to the west line of East 21st Street, in the City of Portland, Oregon, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to make a survey and plat of the widening of East Glisan Street, from the east line of East 16th Street to the west line of East 21st Street, by acquiring 20 feet off the north side of East Glisan Street between East 16th Street and a point 100 feet east of the east line of East 20th Street; and also, by acquiring triangular parcels off the north and south sides of East Glisan Street sufficient to continue a 75 foot street from a point 100 feet east of the east line of East 20th Street to the west line of East 21st Street, and a written report thereon as provided by the City Charter.
