

Resolution No. 18593

WHEREAS, in the matter of eliminating the grade crossings of certain streets and railroad tracks in conjunction with the Lovejoy Street viaduct approach to Broadway Bridge, an award of damages has been made by Ordinance No. 54546 for securing the contemplated rights of way and easements, and ~~various~~ have been drawn in favor of the persons entitled to damages in accordance thereof; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that Lovejoy Street from the west line of 13th Street to the east line of 14th Street; 14th Street, from the north line of Kearney Street to the south line of ~~Lawrence~~ Street; 10th Street, from the north line of Johnson Street to the south line of Lovejoy Street; and the northwest and northeast corners of 1st, 11th Street and Lovejoy Street, be and the same are hereby declared opened, laid out and established as city street as provided by Ordinance No. 54546, adopting the report of the City Engineer, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Engineer be and he is hereby instructed to record with the County Clerk of Multnomah County, Oregon, within ninety days after the adoption of this resolution a copy of the resolution and a map of said street widening and easements.
