

RESOLUTION NO. 19481

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council that Multnomah county, Oregon, by its Commissioners, entered a final order, numbered 2575, dated the 29th day of January, 1930, surrendering to the City of Portland its jurisdiction over Broadway Drive, a road 40 feet in width, from the south line of Grant street to the east line of Georgian Court, a certified copy of said order being filed with the auditor, and said order being made and entered after full compliance by the Board of County Commissioners with the statutes of the state of Oregon governing the surrender of county roads to municipalities; and

WHEREAS, no award of damages has been made, inasmuch as no damages have been sustained by any one, and there has been no assessment of benefits, inasmuch as no damages have been awarded, and it appears to the Council that said county road should be laid out, taken over, and established as a city street; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Portland, Oregon, that said portion of said county road be and the same is hereby taken over, laid out, and established as a city street, and the City of Portland from this time forward shall have exclusive jurisdiction and control of said portion of said county road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the auditor forward to the County Commissioners of Multnomah county, Oregon, a copy of this resolution.
